Subj: ADULT AND CHILD IMMUNIZATIONS RECORD TEST FORMS

1. Purpose. To announce test forms NAVMED 6230/4 and NAVMED 6230/5. These test forms shall be used in place of the SF 601.

2. Background. Reference (a) provides basic guidance on immunizations and chemoprophylaxis. Any requirements or recommendations of reference (a) not specifically modified by this notice remain in effect. Reference (b) provides updated information about all aspects of immunization. Per reference (b), reference (c) requires documentation of certain information when a vaccine is administered. This includes manufacturer, lot number, and edition date of vaccine information materials provided. Current paper forms, SF 601, DD 2766, and NAVMED 6150/20 do not accommodate recording this information. Electronic health data systems will eventually be in use enterprise-wide, and will capture all required data. In the interim, there is a need for a paper form that accommodates all required vaccination information.

3. Information. Enclosures (1) and (2) shall be used in recording required vaccination information when paper forms are needed. Begin using this form immediately. Do not transcribe information from old forms; instead, retain previous immunization records in the health record.

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5. Forms. NAVMED 6230/4 and NAVMED 6230/5 are available via the Bureau of Medicine and Surgery Web site at <http://navymedicine.med.navy.mil/instructions/external/external.htm>. Local reproduction is authorized; however, since this is a test form, no more than a 6-month supply is recommended.

6. Cancellation Contingency. Retain until incorporated into reference (a).
