This letter to the Corps focuses on the 21st Century Religious Program Specialist (RP). The Senior Enlisted Advisor focused his latest letter on Task Force Excel (TFE) and how it has already begun to revolutionize the training and education of RPs. TFE helps us in refocusing RP functions, tasks, and training, to meet the challenges ahead.
